Where History Meets Hospitality.

Richmond was founded in 1798 by Colonel John Miller, a Revolutionary War soldier. In 1798, the Kentucky Legislature authorized the moving of the Madison County seat from nearby Milford to the land owned by Col. Miller. The move was bitterly opposed by about 300 residents of Milford and a fight to retain the seat resulted between Dave Kennedy, who represented Milford, and William Kearly, who represented the new site.

Although history does not record the results of the brawl, the county approved the move in March 1798 and two acres of land were purchased from Col. Miller. Court was held in his barn. On July 4, 1798, the site was officially named Richmond in honor of Miller's birthplace, Richmond, Virginia.

In 1809 Richmond was incorporated. Trustees of the town appointed were: James French, John Patrick, William Irvine, Christopher Irvine and Archibald Curie. Col. John Miller gave 50 acres of land to the trustees of Richmond to be surveyed and laid off into lots and streets by Major John Crook.

The first Courthouse in Richmond was a plain brick building designed by Tyra Rodes in 1799. It stood 50 years. Construction of the present Greek Revival Courthouse began in 1848, and was completed in 1852. During the Battle of Richmond, the present Courthouse was used as a hospital for Union and Confederate soldiers.

Richmond takes pride in being the hometown of a Minister to Russia and five Governors: William J. Stone, Governor of Missouri; James B. McCreary, twice Governor of Kentucky; David R. Francis, Governor of Missouri; Green Clay Smith, Governor of Montana Territory; Keene Johnson, Governor of Kentucky, and Cassius Marcellus Clay, Minister to Russia during 1861, 1863, and 1869.

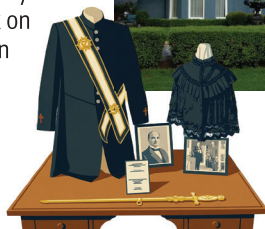

HISTORICAL ATTRACTIONS

Richmond is a city rich with history, from the early frontier days to Civil War battles and historic architecture. If you are interested in exploring the past while experiencing the northernmost southern hospitality, you should check out the following itinerary:

1. Step into the 18th century at **Fort Boonesborough** (April-October), founded by legendary frontiersman, Daniel Boone, in 1775. This replica fort offers living history demonstrations, pioneer craft exhibits, and stories of Kentucky's earliest settlers.
2. After stepping back into the pioneer days at the Fort, continue your journey through history with a visit to **White Hall** (April-October). Tour the grand 19th-century mansion of Cassius Marcellus Clay, an outspoken emancipationist and ambassador to Russia. With stunning Italianate architecture and period furnishings, White Hall offers a glimpse into Kentucky's political and social history.
3. From White Hall, take a Joy Ride down US-25 from exit 95 to exit 83 to explore the grounds where the **Battle of Richmond** took place. The Battle of Richmond is one of the most significant Civil War battles in Kentucky. Interactive exhibits bring Richmond's history to life as you walk the preserved battlefield.
4. Before returning to one of Richmond's hotels or short-term rentals, stop by the Richmond Visitors Center to pick up our **Downtown Walking Tour**. Completely self-guided, this booklet features over 60 historic buildings, including the (recommended) starting point, the **Irvinton House Museum** off Lancaster Avenue.



LIVE LIKE A LOCAL

Want to see and experience Richmond the way the locals do? This itinerary takes you beyond the typical tourist stops and into the heart of the community - where good coffee, hidden gems, and hometown traditions make for the perfect day.

1. There's no better way to wake up than with a handcrafted latte or cold brew from **Purdy's**, a downtown favorite. Grab a pastry, settle in by the window, and enjoy the cozy, welcoming atmosphere as Richmond starts to stir.
2. After your morning caffeine, head to **Lake Reba Park** for a peaceful walk along the scenic trails. Whether you prefer a casual stroll, a jog, or just want to sit by the water, this spot is a go-to for locals looking to enjoy the fresh air.
3. Nothing says 'local favorite' like a hearty meal at **Apollo Pizza Emporium**. Whether you're in the mood for their signature pizza or their garlic breadsticks, this laid-back downtown spot serves up comfort food with a side of community charm.
4. After lunch, take a leisurely walk through **Richmond's Mill District**, where you'll find a mix of charming boutiques and small businesses. From stylish finds at **Stark Southern Boutique** to unique gifts at **Apparitions** and **Second & Main**, you never know what bags you'll have to pack into your trip home.
5. After your day of exploring Richmond, it's time to kick back and enjoy a cold one at **Dreaming Creek Brewery**. This local hangout offers a rotating selection of craft brews in a laid-back setting inspired by Daniel Boone's frontier adventures. Your day in Richmond started and ended with drinks hand-crafted in Richmond, something our locals appreciate about their home.

NATURE IS CALLING

1. Start your morning with fresh air and peaceful views at **Lake Reba Park**. Take a relaxing walk or jog along the scenic trails, where the gentle sounds of nature and the sight of the tranquil lake create the perfect setting to begin your day. Keep an eye out for birds you may not see in your hometown, or, if you're feeling adventurous, rent a kayak or cast a line for a quiet fishing experience on the water.
2. Next, trade open paths for a wooded retreat at **Camp Catalpa**. Just a short drive away, this quiet escape offers shaded walking trails and a disc golf course, making it a great spot for a different kind of outdoor adventure. Nearby, **Taylor Fork Ecological Area** invites you to explore diverse landscapes, from wetlands to grasslands and forests - a hidden gem for those who love to immerse themselves in nature.
3. After your morning on the trails, refuel with a classic Kentucky meal at **Newby Country Store**. Tucked away in the western part of Madison County, this charming stop is known for its delicious deli sandwiches and a selection of locally made sauces and mixes - perfect for bringing a taste of Kentucky back home with you.
4. A short drive along US-25 will take you to the **Battle of Richmond Park**, where you can combine your love for the outdoors with a deeper appreciation for the past. Walk or bike along the trails that wind through one of Kentucky's most well-preserved Civil War battlefields. The rolling terrain and open fields offer a peaceful, reflective experience after your morning adventures.
5. End your day with a sunset and a glass of local wine at **Chenault Vineyards**. Unwind on the scenic outdoor patio with a glass of your new favorite wine, soaking in the beauty of the Kentucky hills as the sun sets below the horizon. Depending on the day you are visiting us, you might even catch live music - so check ahead if you'd like to add a little extra entertainment to your evening.
